

FALL 2011 HEY Class

(Homestead Enrichment for Youth)

The Homestead PTA is offering our students an after school enrichment program beginning September 26, 2011. The classes will be held **Monday** and **Wednesdays** from **3:45-4:45pm**. Supervision will be provided from 3:30-3:45. We require a minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 15 students per class. The tuition for each course is \$30. The class attendance dates are as follows:

Course descriptions are attached. For classes with more than 15 students applying, we will hold a lottery. The first 15 names drawn will be accepted. We will make every effort to accommodate those not accepted in their second choice. Additionally, if not at least 6 students sign up for a class, the class will be cancelled.

Please fill out the form below and send it and your check(s) in an envelope marked "HEY". **Make your checks payable to Homestead PTA.** Please **send a SEPARATE check for each child and for each class.** If your child signs up for 2 different classes we should have a separate check for each class, even though both checks are for the same child. We strongly recommend a secondary class choice due to class size limits. Your check will be returned in the event that we cannot place the student in a class of his/her choice.

The registration deadline is September 16, 2011. No late registrations will be accepted. You will receive confirmation by September 23, 2011 so you can schedule accordingly. If you do not receive any notification, you should contact Angie McCauley, amccauley319@yahoo.com.

We do not provide supervision after 4:45pm. Therefore, it is important to have your child picked up on time. An emergency contact person and phone number is **required** to enroll your child in class. This contact person needs to be available should you be delayed. All children will exit through door 3, just as after school parent pick up. Please note on the below form how your child will be going home. If your child's dismissal changes from what you note below then you **MUST SEND A CHANGE OF TRANSPORTATION NOTE WITH YOUR CHILD TO HEY CLASS THAT DAY(a copy is included below).**
