### \*\*\*Reminders\*\*\*

**Kindergartners:** PHYSICALS DUE 10/1/10!!!! Please turn in your Eye exams (DUE 10/15/10) and Dental Exams ASAP!

**Second graders:** Please turn in your DENTAL EXAMS ASAP!

**Everyone:** All medications and over the counter items must be brought in by a parent and have a signed doctor's order on the School Medication Authorization Form (see district website).

~Please review school policy: children with vomiting/diarrhea, frequent cough, or temperature over 100 need to stay home for at least 24hours

**Student's with Medications at School:** Please remember parents must bring medications to and from school, and a doctor's order is needed for all medications, including OTC (over the counter) medications and throat lozenges/cough drops!

### \*\*\*Registration Requirements\*\*\*

**Kindergarten:** IL State Physical, complete with immunizations, lead screening, diabetic screening, height and weight, and doctor's signature. Eye Exam (Not vision screening). Dental Exam.

**Second Grade:** Dental Exam.

**Fifth Grade:** Hepatitis B Vaccine Series (Proof needed only if not completed by Kindergarten)

**All Grades: Annual Health History Forms** (Sent home in your registration packet). **IF YOU RECEIVED ANOTHER ANNUAL HEALTH HISTORY FORM, WHICH WAS SENT HOME, PLEASE SEND BACK IN TOMORROW!**

\*\*\*Needed items: The nurse's office is in need of large pants for boys & girls sizes 14-16 or L-XL sweatpants. Also, boys' underwear, socks, gloves, mittens, and hats\*\*\*.
